“Whisperers of the Jungle” orphans, Arusha, Tanzania

This registered charity in Tanzania began when a group of orphans chose the name saying “We are the whisperers, the forgotten, the unheard people and where we live is definitely a jungle”

AMARA Aid has had the privilege to help finance these young people by donating £10,000 twice a year towards living accommodation, food & clothing, education and medical care. From its initiation “WOTJ” has grown from 5 to over 90 children and young people of varying ages. An e-mail recently received at the AMARA Aid office reports “We remember all who have been doing special efforts to support the children to stay in school without any problem up to now. Special thanks for the practical gifts sent from AMARA supporters at Easter time. During Lent we had prayers and fasting for 40 days for all donors and supporters that God would mightily Bless them in all that they do”. AMARA Aid would like to thank everyone who has given financially, prayerfully and practically towards these needy young people over the past year. It is plain to see that the support that we give in gifts and in love and affection for them has made a big difference in their lives.

They had come to Whisperers of the Jungle in distress, hungry and afraid having lost their parents to either AIDS or accidents (one young boy’s mother even took him to a strange town many miles away from his home, made an excuse of going to a funeral and never returned for him). He made his way to Arusha where he heard of Whisperers of the jungle who cared for young people like himself and has become a very bright and pleasant young man.



Please pray for these children – all of their stories are heart-breaking! When another young man of 17 came he had suffered from cancer for two years. Quickly a place was found for him in a hospital in Dar-es-Salaam where treatment started immediately. As he was an orphan no one would pay for his hospital fees. When he arrived it was discovered that because of his status cancer treatment was FREE. This hospital specialised in cancer research and through prayer, expertise of the hospital staff and this young man’s faith he is now healthy and able to walk unaided. God answers prayer! He is hoping to

finish his education and then apply for a job as a Safari driver – his life long ambition. We wish him well for the future. Your donations made this possible by initially sending him to the hospital and then giving a small salary to a lady who made a home for him in Dar-es-Salaam and took him back and forward to the hospital for his treatment. Offering him care and sympathy when he needed it most.
