## **NEW BUSINESS START-UP PROJECT**

As some of Amara Aid's orphans are now over 21 years of age we are helping in a small way to finance the start up of a business for them.

For example Annastazia has had a hearing problem for many years now and although she did well in education she is now based at home baking pastries and bread for the neighbourhood. Previously she made crisps from bananas to supplement the household finances. Two other orphan girls live with her and attend the local technical college. These young people have been supported by Amara Aid since a young age and have grown into lovely adults.

#### **NEW SCHOOL FEEDING PROGRAMME IN MOZAMBIQUE**

This programme started in March 2021. Due to covid the government only allow small groups of 50 to come to school for a short time each day. So at the moment 150 are getting fed on a daily basis. There are 300 children on the register at the school but they come on alternate days Monday – Saturday.

The children were delighted and very much enjoyed their school meals.
